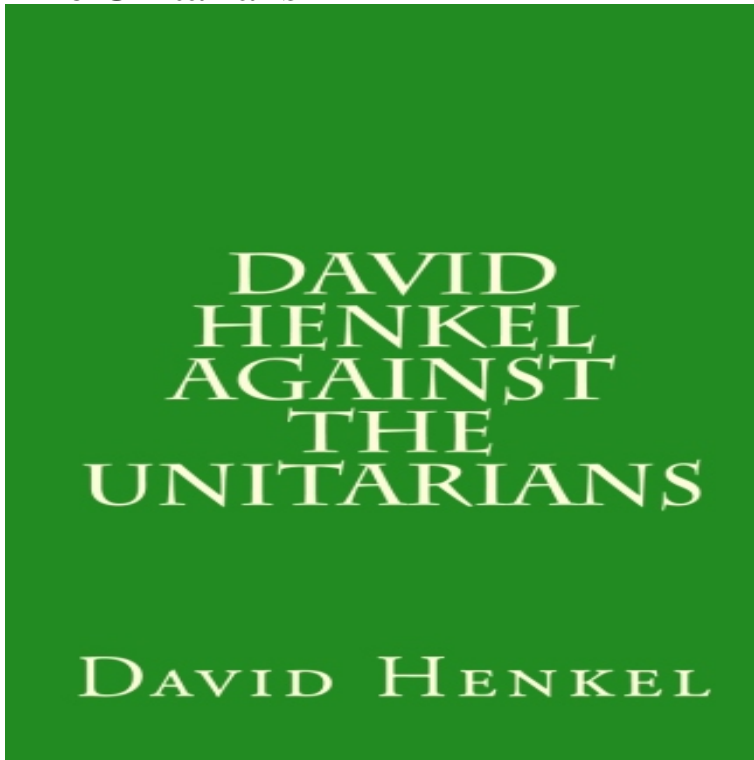


The Unitarians
